## 12-59 Hospital Provider Manual Updates

### Section 1 - Hospital Inpatient and Outpatient

- #1 General Policy, A

The paragraph beginning “Readmissions within 30 days...” is being amended to refer to Utah Administrative Rule R414-1-12.

- #3 Limitations, #10 *Readmissions Within 30 Days of Previous Discharge*

This is being amended to refer to Utah Administrative Rule R414-1-12.

- #3 Limitations, #11 *Exceptions to the 30 Day Readmission Policy*

This is being amended to refer to Utah Administrative Rule R414-1-12.

- #3 Limitations, #14 – The verbiage has been removed.

- #4 Non-Covered Services, #15 – The verbiage has been removed.

- #4 Non-Covered Services, #17 – The verbiage has been removed.

- #4 Non-Covered Services, #21 sub-bullets (1) and (2) – The verbiage has been removed.

- #4 Non-Covered Services, #26 – Now reads as follows:

“Surgical procedures that are unproven or experimental are non-covered Medicaid services.”

- #4 Non-Covered Services, #27 regarding “Never Events”

For inpatient hospital claims, adverse events or “never events” are non-covered in Medicare crossover patients.

Effective July 1, 2011, Medicaid will not pay for provider preventable conditions. See Provider Preventable Conditions (PCC) Diagnosis List in the attachments section.

PPC diagnoses that were not present on admission should not be billed to Medicaid. Providers should ensure all PPC related diagnoses, services and charges are removed prior to submitting the claim. Claims with PPC related diagnoses that are not present on admission will be denied.

PPCs include those conditions noted in 42 CFR 447.26 (e.g., wrong procedure, wrong body part, wrong patient).

Providers are required to report PPCs in accordance with Utah Administrative Rule R414-1.

- #6 Reimbursement for Inpatient Hospital Services

Reimbursement for inpatient hospital services is covered in the Utah State Plan, Attachment 4.19-A.

The following applies to hospitals that are paid using a DRG:

Utah Medicaid uses all submitted diagnoses in determining the DRG on which to base reimbursement. If all submitted diagnoses are “not covered” by Utah Medicaid, then the claim will deny. Otherwise, all submitted diagnoses, whether covered or not, are used to calculate the DRG. Providers must ensure that all submitted diagnoses are appropriate and documented in the patient’s medical record.

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## **12-60 Medical Supplies List Correction**

Please note the following code correction, effective January 1, 2012:

K0007 Extra heavy duty wheelchair. May be purchased; does not require prior authorization.

**12-62      Outpatient Hospital Claims**

Outpatient claims should be billed with a single date of service which includes all services rendered. Claims containing multiple dates may experience processing delays and incorrect denials.
