Nursing facilities must arrange for specialized rehabilitative services (SRS) for residents with intellectual disabilities or related conditions. To apply, the resident must have a **Preadmission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) Level II Evaluation** which indicates the resident needs specialized rehabilitation and the facility must assure the needed services are provided by qualified personnel under the written order of a physician.

The nursing facility must document the need for specialized rehabilitative services in the comprehensive care plan. Rehabilitation services may include:

- Medication management and monitoring effectiveness/side effects of psychiatric medication.
- Provision of a structured environment to include structured socialization activities.
- Development, maintenance, and implementation of programs designed to teach daily living skills.
- Formal behavior modification programs.
- Development of appropriate support networks.

The application must include the following documentation:

- An ID/RC PASRR Level II which indicates the resident needs specialized rehabilitative services.
- A signed physician order which specifically allows specialized rehabilitative services.
- A copy of the comprehensive plan of care which documents the SRS program.
- Complete formal program that includes specific goals and defines staff that will document the progress and revise the program when the goal is met.
- Tracking sheets that document the progress of the program daily, including staff that are responsible for completing the daily program.
- Documentation of professionals who specialize in providing specialized rehabilitative services outside of the facility (if applicable).
