Why does dental care matter?

- About I in 5 kids has an untreated cavity.
- Tooth decay can be prevented.
- A winning smile increases self-esteem.
- Dental problems cause kids to miss school.
- Good oral health improves nutrition.

Children enrolled in CHIP or Medicaid can get:

- Regular dental check-ups
- Regular dental cleanings
- Fluoride treatments
- Dental sealants
- Dental treatments, as needed

Recent changes for Medicaid include:

- Reimbursement rates have increased (Medicaid fee-for-service only)

- Increased frequency limitations for children, as shown below

Code	Service	Frequency
D0120	Periodic Oral Evaluation	Increased from 2 to 4 per calendar year
D1206*	Topical application of fluoride varnish	Increased from 2 to 4 per calendar year
D1120	Prophylaxis – Child (Age 0-15)	Increased from 2 to 4 per calendar year
