## *Why does dental care matter?*

- About 1 in 5 kids has an untreated cavity.
- Tooth decay can be prevented.
- A winning smile increases self-esteem.
- Dental problems cause kids to miss school.
- Good oral health improves nutrition.

## *What can you do?*

- Clean your child's teeth.
- Get your child's first dental visit by age one.
- Teach your child how to brush and floss.
- Visit the dentist every six months for preventive dental care.
- Get dental sealants on your child's permanent molars.
- Ask your doctor about fluoride treatment.

- Regular dental check-ups
- Regular dental cleanings
- Fluoride treatments
- Dental sealants
- Dental treatments, as needed
