



# Utah's Premium Partnership for Health Insurance (UPP)

It's time to get... UPP for health insurance

### What's UPP?

Utah's Premium Partnership for Health Insurance (pronounced "up") helps make health insurance more affordable for families and individuals.

Depending on your income and family size, you may qualify for a rebate of up to \$300 per person each month if you are:

- Uninsured and have access to health insurance through your employer.
- Eligible for COBRA coverage.
- Enrolled in COBRA coverage.

## **Employer-sponsored insurance**

If you have health insurance offered at work, UPP may be able to help you pay your monthly premium. You may be eligible if you:

- Don't currently have health insurance.
- Are eligible to enroll in your employer's health plan.

#### You must apply for UPP before the date that your health insurance coverage begins.

After you enroll in UPP and begin paying your monthly premium, you will receive:

- Up to \$300 per adult each month.
- Up to \$180 per child each month.
- Options for your child's dental coverage.

# **COBRA coverage**

COBRA is a federal law. It gives formerly employed individuals the option to temporarily keep their employer-sponsored health insurance. Unfortunately, COBRA can be very expensive because the enrollee must now pay 100% of the cost.

UPP may be able to help you pay a portion of your monthly COBRA premium. You may be eligible if you:

- Are already enrolled in COBRA coverage.
- Are eligible to enroll in COBRA coverage.

After you enroll in UPP and begin paying your COBRA premium, you will receive:

- Up to \$300 per adult each month.
- Up to \$180 per child each month.
- Options for your child's dental coverage.

# **Do I Qualify?**

To qualify, you and your family must meet the following guidelines:

- You are a U.S. citizen or legal resident
- You are age 0-64
- You meet income guidelines (see chart below)
- Your cost of health insurance is more than 5% of your income
