When the state visits a place where you receive services, they are looking to see if it meets the Settings Rule requirements. As part of this process, the state is gathering information and feedback on the setting, individuals receiving services, and their caregivers.

If you choose to provide feedback, it will not affect the services you receive in any way and all information will be kept confidential.
