Jeff Nelson gave an update on Public Health Emergency Unwinding. Dashboard-Feb 13, 2023

#### Questions:

Russ Elbel asked about the DWS workload tracking. It was mentioned you can see those individuals transition to CHIP, or who has been referred to the ACA, what kind of outreach will the individual get if not being transitioned?

Jeff Nelson mentioned as in any case when the member is going to leave the Medicaid program, we would send that information to the health plans and notifying the member (at 10-day notice) before closing their account. Medicaid ineligible cases will be automatically transferred to the federal marketplace.

Stephanie Burdick asked can you walk us through how the state will resume charging spenddowns?

Jeff Nelson mentioned that there are two things that need to happen before we can charge a spenddown. 1) We must get past April  $1^{st}$ , that is when the requirement is officially over to keep cases open. 2) The member's case must be reviewed to ensure the spenddown amount is correct. The member's income may have changed over the time, or they might not be in the right program. They might be transitioning to full-service Medicaid where there is no cost, or even increasing the spenddown amount owed.

Michael Hales asked one of the provisions of the consolidated appropriations act was a requirement for the agency to continue receiving the enhanced federal participation that prior to you terminating someone form the roles that you must undertake a good faith effort to contact the individual using more than one modality. What processes do you have in place to ensure that you've used more than one modality?

Jeff Nelson mentioned that there is more guidance coming out from CMS on this. Example of a member who is not reachable. Let's say it's November, we are trying to do their renewal we realize that we can't complete it on our own, so we've reached out to them and mailed the information to them, the return mail comes back undeliverable, we do not have a phone number on file for them. That question has been raised to CMS, not yet been answered. We're not sure how this is going to be implemented but plan to use a second modality, likely a phone call for most, to connect with the member. (This only applies to those who would otherwise close due to returned mail going unopened.)
