


Request


Utah Percent Uninsured - Subcategory




Utah Number Uninsured - Subcategory




Surrounding **States** Uninsured Rate* Total (2023)




Surrounding **States** Uninsured Rate* <138% FPL (2023)




Surrounding **States** Uninsured Rate* **Under 6 Years** (2023)




Surrounding **States** Uninsured Rate* **6-18 Years** (2023)
