Pharmacy Point of Sale Claims Submission Clarification Code Update

Effective December 1, 2024, the following submission clarification codes may be used on pharmacy point-of-sale claims NCPDP Field 420-DK:

"2" Mandatory 90-day supply exception: The pharmacist is indicating that in their professional judgment or otherwise inappropriate as directed by the provider to have a 90-day supply. (Please note: Pharmacy claims will be closely monitored to ensure that 90-day supply claims are being processed when appropriate.)

"3" Vacation Supply: The pharmacist is indicating that the cardholder has requested a vacation supply of the medicine

"4" Lost/Damaged Prescription: The pharmacist is indicating that the cardholder has requested replacement of medication that has been damaged or lost.
